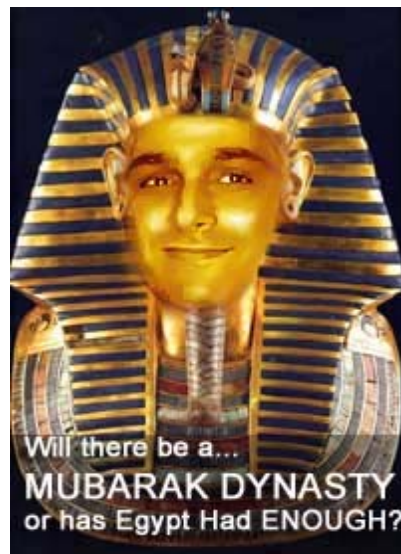

Minutes of Meeting, Saturday, July 16, 2005
LaSalle Bank Room, The Oriental Institute

The members' business meeting that was to be convened at 4:00 was postponed because of horrific traffic that delayed the Secretary. The president put out the new sign in sheets.

The president made announcements about educational programs at the Oriental Institute and the plans for two exhibits in conjunction with the Field Museum's presentation of the "Tut" show.

The program began at 5:00. The speaker Farouk Mustafa addressed "The New Pharaohs? The Egyptian Elections and the Kefaya Movement." An announcement was made that the program was supported by a grant from the US State Department. Emily gave the speaker a personal check. She will be reimbursed from the chapter. The president thanked the speaker.

2 ARCE mugs and one tote bag were sold.

After a short break for wine and cheese (thanks again to Dennis Kelley for providing a cheese/fruit plate and sandwiches), we convened the business meeting at 6:20 with Sandy Polley presiding.

Polley introduced the members' packet with copies of all materials generated by the chapter to date, copies of the proposed by-laws and practices.

There was a call for donations (\$113 was received).

The acting treasurer, Sherian McLaughin gave her report. After the last meeting, her purse was stolen. It contained all the forms for establishing the Citibank account as well as the cash (\$180) and check (\$230) proceeds from the Lehner breakfast (total \$310). She appealed to those who had written checks to cancel the original check and write new one. She will cover restore the lost cash. She brought duplicate paperwork form Citibank to open the ARCE Chicago checking account.

We discussed the need to apply for the FEIN Number.

Polley offered to give on line help for using the web site.

We need to check the e-mail list. Several members are not listed.

Polley and Teeter appealed to help in running the chapter.

The prospect of inviting Zahi Hawass to Chicago when he is in Dayton was discussed.

The ballot in the packet was discussed. A new ballot will be sent by e-mail. All ballots for election of the Board should be returned by July 31. Teeter made an appeal to approve the By-laws, which can always be emended later.

Bob Andersen noted that we had a quorum. He moved to accept the By-Laws, Dennis Kelly seconded. The group voted to approve and adopt the By-Laws.

Anderson suggested that we change the ballot to elect 5 Members of the Board (per article V, p. 9). Suggestion accepted by the group.
